The Department of East Asian Languages and Literatures offers an undergraduate major in Japanese. The major program includes studies in language, literature, and linguistics. The total number of hours for a Japanese major is 55, in addition to 25 hours of prerequisites. A course counted for one category cannot be counted for another category.
